# INTRODUCTION

We are pleased to introduce the new **Registered Interface** module, which allows you to view, manage, and control all interfaces registered for a selected property. With this module, you can enable, disable, or remove registered interfaces based on your access rights, making interface management more efficient and straightforward.

## PREREQUISITES

To access and use the Registered Interface module, you must have the appropriate role access:

#### 1. System Configuration Role:

- Access to view, search, and sort functionalities within the Registered Interface module.
- 2. Interface Setup and System Configuration Role:
  - Access to view, search, sort, edit (enable/disable), and remove functionalities within the Registered Interface module.

## **GETTING STARTED**

To access the Registered Interface module:

- 1. Select the **System Configuration** menu option.
- 2. Go to the Interface Management section.
- 3. Select the **Registered Interface** module.

The Registered Interface module provides a user-friendly interface that includes the following components:

#### 1. Multi-Property Drop-Down List:

- Select the desired property to view its registered interfaces.
- 2. Search Field:
  - Enter the Interface Name or Machine Name to search for specific interfaces.

#### 3. Sorting Options:

• Sort the registered interfaces by Interface Name, Machine Name, or Status.

#### 4. Interface Name:

- Displays the list of interface names registered for the selected property.
- 5. Machine Name:
  - Shows the machine names associated with the respective registered interfaces.
- 6. **Status:** 
  - Indicates the status (enabled or disabled) of each interface.
- 7. Edit Button:



• Click to enable or disable a specific interface.

#### 8. Delete Button:

• Click to remove a registered interface from the system.
