Overview

This document contains release notes for the latest Survey release.

Improvements and new features

This release includes the following improvements and new features:

Comment analysis

• **Restored connection for enhanced comment analysis:** Comments are now successfully pushed for analysis following a resolution to the connection issues that began on May 20, 2024. This issue had affected the comment analysis and frequent word sections of the new dashboard, causing a backlog in the surveyfrontend.CommentAnalysisQueue. The resolution applies universally and is not specific to any single client, ensuring consistent functionality across all user platforms.

Fixed issues

- **Successful addition of notifications without errors:** An issue with the API responsible for adding permissions, which previously caused errors during notification setup, has been resolved. Users can now add notifications smoothly without encountering error dialogs, ensuring more reliable communication.
- **Corrected user display in Users tab:** The system no longer displays the currently logged-in user under the Users tab, enhancing the user interface's clarity and user management functionality.
- **Reliable permission removal:** An issue with the API that handles permission removal has been resolved. Users can now successfully remove permissions without experiencing failures, ensuring smoother management of access controls.
- **Resolved error on opening the new dashboard:** An issue causing an error to appear when opening the new GUESTScope Dashboard has been addressed. Previously, this error raised concerns about data accuracy and only resolved upon closing the window. The underlying cause has been identified and resolved to ensure a seamless user experience.
- **Corrected department appears on the Details by Department page:** An issue was identified on the Details by Department page of the STAFFScope Activity Report affecting three locations. Previously, the report incorrectly displayed non-relevant departments and duplicated sub-departments. Departments were shown despite not being included in the respective location's survey or Web Result tables. This error has been corrected to ensure that only relevant departments are displayed, aligning with dynamic survey branching rules.
- **Resolved issue with permission-related API:** Previously, an API crucial for managing permissions was failing, which prevented users from being created without exceptions. This issue has now been resolved, ensuring that users can be added smoothly and without errors.
